what we accomplished over the past year.

VOLUNTEER

Some of the largest ways we built our community through volunteerism include our Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program that brought back more than \$2.6 million into our community, brought together over 1,600 volunteers during our Day of Caring event, and expanded our work in our volunteer centers in Jones, Benton, Cedar, and Linn counties.

INVEST

We continue to support our nonprofit partners by investing over \$3 million back into our community. We are very excited to hold that number steady this coming year as we use our Unite to Inspire strategy to stay focused on creating solutions to our community's most pressing needs.

ADVOCATE

We have increased our focus on advocacy through initiatives such as BOLD, or Board Orientation Leadership Development, and Civic Circle. Both are programs that educate people on how to be community leaders. We're proud this last year has included many hours and work spent in collaborations such as the moving the work of the Alliance for Equitable Housing forward, helping the Flourishing Neighborhood Index launch in Wellington Heights, and working through the Opportunity Center to partner our Women United volunteers with women from ASAC's WayHome in a mentoring pilot.

These are just a few examples of our daily work to bring our community together **VIA** United Way. We're grateful for your support. We look forward to keeping pace in the coming

year as we create an Eastern Iowa where everyone can thrive.

As she leads them through the paperwork during her regular volunteer shift their anxiety grows and it's then that she explains how tax credits work in their favor. At the end, the couple is overjoyed to know they will be receiving a refund and declare they can put part of it toward paying off their car. High-fives, big smiles, and connection are just part of the impact felt.

This is just one example of how United Way has impacted our community through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance, or VITA, program. This past tax season, over 1,800 refunds across two counties in Eastern Iowa were processed bringing back more than \$2.6 million to Eastern Iowans and helping bring financial stability to our community.
