Fostering childhood success is crucial in the early ages of childhood, and it doesn't end there. Our children are the future, and we are continuing to invest in them. Our focus is on shaping early childhood opportunities as well as our future workforce.

WHAT ARE THE ISSUES?

In Linn County, only 63% of children met the benchmark of being kindergarten ready. The overall graduation rate in Linn County is 85% This rate drops significantly to 73% for those enrolled in free and reduced lunch programs, and further to 70% for Black students in this county.

HOW IS UWECI ADDRESSING THIS ISSUE?

With your support, we are working with community stakeholders to develop strategies that assist both parents and children. In addition, we are aligning our work to support teens and young adults in their career path.
